

# ORO-MEDONTE

Outdoor adventure in a Fall wonderland

## ORO-MEDONTE (125km/2 Hours) ~

Take Bass Lake Side Road past picturesque Bass Lake Provincial Park of Oro-Medonte onto Old Barrie Rd via Line 10 and be immersed into forests of red, yellow and orange.

Continue through the rolling countryside along the First Line to Bidwell to Highway 93 and into Craighurst, a quaint little village with restaurants and shops.

Turn onto Horseshoe Valley Road where you can play a round of golf, zip line through the trees or hike the trails the Copeland Forest.

There's no shortage of Autumn beauty along Line 6 into the Mount St. Louis area.

Continue to the 11th Line, follow to Horseshoe Valley Road and into Jarrett. The Oro-Medonte countryside is beautiful and your next few kilometers will be all about the views.

Take the 7th Line to Bass Lake Side Road, your connection to the 9th line. Follow the 9th line to Ridge Road and enjoy the view from the dock overlooking Lake Simcoe.

The journey is coming to an end, follow the 15th line to highway 11 and back into Orillia.

## THINGS TO DO ALONG THE WAY

### PLAY

Swing from the trees at Treetop Trekking, hit a golf ball at Settler's Ghost, play a round of disc golf at Hardwood Ski and Bike or rent a mountain bike.

### EXPLORE

Explore a key piece of the Canadian history at Oro-Medonte African Church.

### CAPTURE

Adventure through Copeland Forest, or Bass Lake Provincial Park and capture breathtaking photos.

### EAT

Enjoy a delicious lunch or dinner at Amiche Restaurant, Crazy Horse Bar and Grill or Horseshoe Valley.
